## **BOARD HIGHLIGHTS:**

- The Board was presented with the return on investments for both the Corporation and the Foundation. Our investments are starting to grow again as the market picks up.
- The 2025-2026 Budget was approved by the Board for all 5 Departments (Phase 1/Phase 2/Phase3/Supportive Housing and Kitchen).
- The Executive Director informed the Board that we were successful in obtaining funding for over \$100,000 dollars from the Ontario Government for improvements to heating, safety systems and communications systems.
- By-laws were updated by the By-law Committee for the Foundation and were submitted for approval to the full Board.
