Maintenance Update:

Please remember not to disturb the plants on the ledges on the 2nd floor, or anywhere around the grounds. These flowers and plants are well cared for and loved by many residents. We do not want to see plants and flowers harmed in any way.

Please be kind and clean up after your pets. Just another gentle reminder to use the poop and scoop bags by the Rec Hall to clean up after your pooch!

Please remember that the patio and all other covered sitting areas, including the gazebo and pergolas are all non-smoking areas. You must be at least 9m away from the door of the covered area. Non-smoking signs indicate areas where smoking is prohibited. Smoking is only allowed in designated areas.

A reminder not to leave anything valuable outside. While we have security cameras installed, we can not see all the areas around Legion Village. Items outside are left at your own risk, so please take care in bringing items inside if possible.

Another reminder of the cooling stations at Legion Village. All lounges in Phase 1, Phase 3 Blue room and Solarium are cooling stations 24 hours a day. The Rec Hall is a cooling station Monday to Friday from 8:00 am -5: 00 PM. Please do not adjust the temperatures on the air conditioning units or turn them off. They are set at temperatures to keep the rooms cool. Please keep all doors closed to keep the cool temperatures effective.
