JANUARY BOARD HIGHLIGHTS:

The Board has approved the financials for both the Corporation and the Foundation. Both are doing significantly better, now that the interest rates have climbed back up.

The Board approved three major studies that are required for the Expansion Project, the Stormwater and Functional Services study, an Environmental Study, and a Traffic impact Study. We expect them to be completed in the spring or summer of this year.

On behalf of the Board of Directors, I extend my warm thanks to Dianne Dunk for her years of service to the Board of Directors as a Tenant Representative. We wish you well in all of your future endeavours.

We will be opening the Nomination Process to all tenants of Legion Village. Please look on the communication board for further details in the near future, should you want to serve on the Board of Directors.

The Board of Directors has approved a 5% increase to go into effect July 2026 for purchased meals and services at Legion Village. The chart on the last page reflects the increase.

STOOP AND SCOOP

Reminder to all pet owners that YOU are responsible for your pet. We have had some complaints of dogs barking while the owner is out for the day. Please be kind to the other residents and make sure the noise levels remain low. Please be aware that we have had complaints about owners not cleaning up after their pets. We have a station by the rec hall with animal waste bags. It is not Legion Village staff's responsibility to clean up after your pets.

Another gentle reminder to all residents to ensure that you always have your keys with you when entering or leaving the building. We maintain the equipment well, but sometimes it fails us and for that reason it is required that tenants always have their keys. We appreciate your co-operation with this matter.

OFFICE NEWS:

We will be moving some of the Administration Offices. The Executive Director will be in Apartment 133, at the end of Phase 2. This will also serve as a conference room for Management Meetings and some educational opportunities. The Director of Office Operations, Chyvone Samis will be moving into The ED's previous office space. The main office will serve as a staff area and resident waiting area for meetings with Administrative Staff. We hope to have all moves completed by February 13th.
