BOARD HIGHLIGHTS:

- The Board was presented with the return on investments for both the Corporation and the Foundation. Our investments are starting to grow again as the market picks up.
- The 2026-2027 Budget was approved by the Board for all 5 Departments (Phase 1/Phase 2/Phase3/Supportive Housing and Kitchen).
- The Executive Director informed the Board that we were successful in obtaining funding for over \$150,000 dollars from the Ontario Government for improvements to heating, safety systems and communications systems.

MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT REPORT:

Please do not allow unknown individuals into Legion Village

Please ensure that the front and side doors close behind you as you enter the building. Do not allow individuals you do not know into the building. Visitors must use keys or enter a code to be admitted into the building.

Also, do not allow visitors in the building if they are using the panel to get buzzed in if you do not recognize them, or are not expecting visitors. This is for the safety of all residents.

DIETARY REQUESTS

Just a reminder for residents attending Dining Services that we do not provide specialized diets for meal services. Residents are informed before moving in that we do not and can not cater to likes/dislikes, and we provide many options to residents, including 2 meal choices, a sandwich of the day, or ham slices. We do provide accommodations to those residents that have documented allergies to certain foods i.e. shellfish, mustard, strawberries etc. Speak to Cathy to set up an appointment to discuss your allergies. Supportive Housing News

Supportive Housing Program Update

Great news! It's now even easier to get connected with the Supportive Housing program here at Legion Village.

If you're interested in accessing our in-house supports and are not currently on the waiting list, please visit Tammy at Reception to pick up an application form. Once you've completed and returned the form to the office, David will contact you to arrange a brief assessment. If you are eligible, your name will then be added to the waiting list.

Eligibility Requirements:

To qualify, residents must live at Legion Village and require some assistance with daily activities such as personal care, medication support, or general wellness monitoring. Eligibility is determined through a brief assessment to ensure the program is the right fit for your needs.

Please note that the Supportive Housing program is not a medical program and does not replace regular primary health care or routine nursing monitoring.

We look forward to helping you maintain your independence!

Lifeline Buttons – EMERGENCY USE ONLY

Please be reminded that your lifeline button is to be pressed for Emergency Use Only. It is not to be pressed to ask questions or for minor issues. During regular hours (from 8:00 am – 5:00 pm. Monday to Friday, you can reach someone at the front desk at 905-372-8705. After hours (from 5:00 pm – 8:00 am and all weekend) the phone rings to a PSW.

We don't want to discourage you from pressing the button if you are experiencing an emergency. In case of Emergency press the button and a PSW will attend.

FIRST DAY OF SUMMER Sunday, June 21st, 2026 – The first official day of Summer!!! Please note that the process to shut the heat off in the building will be started June 1, 2025. As the warmer temperatures arrive, please be cautious to make sure you keep hydrated, and avoid too much sun exposure.
